

Project123 Usage Guidelines

As a condition of your use of the Services, you will not use the Services for any purpose that is unlawful or prohibited by these terms, conditions, and notices. You may not use the Services in any manner that could damage, disable, overburden, or impair any **Project123** server, or the network(s) connected to any **Project123** server, or interfere with any other party's use of any Services. You may not attempt to gain unauthorized access to any Services, other accounts, computer systems or networks connected to any **Project123** server or to any of the Services, through hacking, password mining or any other means. You may not obtain or attempt to obtain any materials or information through any means not intentionally made available through the Services.

Hardware and Software Configuration

To use the Project123 Service, you must ensure that the following hardware and software are installed at its premises, and that the software is configured to the following settings.

(Note that the information given below regarding how to achieve the required settings is intended as general guidance only, and is not a definitive guide. It is your responsibility to ensure that software has been configured to the required settings.)

Microsoft Windows Settings	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• "Display Options" set to the scheme "Windows Standard" (this scheme can be accessed via the control panel by selecting the display icon, then selecting the "Appearance" tab, then selecting "Windows Standard" in the scheme drop-down).
Internet Explorer Settings	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• "Text Size" to be medium (this can be set via the "View" menu by selecting "Text Size" and then "Medium");• Newer version of stored pages to be checked for every time Internet Explorer is started (this can be set via the "Tools" menu by selecting "Options", then selecting "Settings", and then choosing the button "Every time you start Internet Explorer");• "Print background colors and images" within Internet explorer printing settings to be ON (this can be set via "Internet Options" and the advanced tab);• Margins for printed status reports to be "3.5" (this can be set by accessing the "File" menu, then the "Page Setup" menu);• JavaScript enabled; and• Cookies enabled
